FACILITIES AVAILABLE

GR Educational Institutions offers hostel facilities for both boys and girls from class IV onwards. Built within our secure and serene campus off Kanakapura Road, the hostel is a perfect 'home away from home' that grooms the students into self-reliant, socially sensitive and confident young people, well prepared to face the world the life beyond the campus. Special academic support is extended to students based on their performance after school hours. A number of personality building activities keep them busy and positively occupied.

FACILITIES

Accommodation:

Separate dormitories for boys and girls offer a secure and comfortable environment with CCTV monitoring and dedicated wardens. Each student is allotted a separate bed, individual wardrobe, locker and study table. The hostel is also equipped with clean and well maintained toilets, baths and a community hall.



Dining:

A modern and well-equipped kitchen is connected to a spacious dining hall, close to the hostel, serving hygienic Satvik food to the boarders throughout the week.





Academic activities:

A well-equipped library, reading room and computer lab are accessible by the boarders all-through the day.



Sports & recreation:

A vast sports ground, a well-equipped gymnasium, a variety of indoor/outdoor games and a community hall are available for boarders beyond school hours.



Weekend schedule:

Boarders who remain in the hostel during weekends may partake in the many activities within and beyond the campus including, movie screenings, cultural activities, spiritual discourses, excursions, etc.



Medical Care:

A first-aid room is available 24/7 apart from doctor-on-call facility for boarders.



Telephone & Internet:

A dedicated telephone booth allows boarders to make local/STD/ISD calls to their family at a cost paid through their personal account, at specified times. Internet browsing facility is also available at specified times.



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GENERAL RULES

- All learners are expected to co-operate in maintaining the attractive appearance of the hostel. Above all, this would include an active participation in the prevention of littering.
- Wilful damaging, vandalising or neglect of School property and the property of others, either by writing or by a physical act, is prohibited.
- Theft of School and private property is also prohibited.
- Disruptive, unruly, rude and/or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- The learner will respect the beliefs, culture, dignity and rights of other learners, as well as their right to privacy and confidentiality.
- Language that is seen as pejorative, discriminatory or racist is prohibited.
- Any act that belittles, demeans or humiliates another learner's culture, race or religion is prohibited.
- All learners have the right to an education free of interference, intimidation and/or physical abuse. The learner will respect the property and safety of other learners. Fighting or threatening of other learners is forbidden.
- The learner will respect those learners in positions of authority. A learner who is in a position of authority will conduct himself in a manner befitting someone in authority. He will respect the rights of other learners and will not abuse such authority bestowed upon him through his position.
- The carrying, copying and/or reading of offensive material is prohibited.

NOTE:

Good manners are important at all times. We stress the basic courtesies of boys to girls and pupils to adults. This includes the customary greetings and assistance to each other and our visitors. Lack of manners, including veiled insolence, snide comments and rudeness will not be tolerated.

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
